Civil Aviation Wing was created in the erstwhile Chief Minister's Secretariat vide G.O. No: 1494-GAD of 1987 dated: 20.08.1987. Later on Civil Aviation Department (CAD) was created by General Administrative Department.

One Single Engine Helicopter (Bell-407).

Hanger at Nehru Helipad and Air Force Station, Srinagar.

Hanger at Air force Station Jammu.

#### **Services:-**

- Facilitate the flying commitments of HLG/VVIP's.
- Flying commitments for emergency /medical/ causality evacuation and other State flying operations.
- Currently operating Subsidized Helicopter Services in coordination with MHA at Jammu and Kashmir Division from November to April every year.

## **Maintenance of the Fleet**


Both Helicopters are being maintained by DGCA approved Maintenance Agency M/s Airworks India Pvt. Ltd. hired through tendering process.

The spares/consumables required during maintenance of the Helicopters are being procured from the manufacturer/authorised vendors through the approved Maintenance Agency

The inspections and component replacement are being carried out as per the maintenance programme approved by the DGCA

The Department has also Technical wing including Aircraft Technicians which helps in maintenance and up keep of the fleets in addition to the maintenance agency

## **SOPs for flying operations**

- •Security and frisking at Jammu & Srinagar Airport by CISF and at helipads by the concerned District Police.
- Landing permission is authorized by the District Magistrate.
- Helipads to be barricaded temporarily with single entry/exit points.
- Deployment of SDRF team and Fire fighting Services at Helipads.
